## Celebrating *15 Años* of Cincy-Cinco!!

Cincy-Cinco 2018 was our Quinceañera Fiesta of our now traditional Latino celebration in Cincinnati. Since its startup, we decided to make it a festival that shared many great aspects of Mexican culture AND of all Latin America. As every year, our stage was nonstop fun, dance and music with excellent folkloric dancing from Panama, Colombia, Mexico and Peru. Wonderful to see local group, Cincinnati Baila that not so long ago made their debut on the Cincy-Cinco stage and now has grown and matured as a company. We were particularly proud to have the attendees singing along the "Viva Cincinnati", a special song by Mexican Composer Alfonso Victoria, that celebrates the joy and appreciation of those Latinos who now call Cincinnati home.

Another success was the introduction of TACOPOLIS. Over the past 15 years, there has been a tremendous growth of authentic Latino, mainly Mexican, restaurants in the tristate area.
